*NOTE: Joan was John's second of three wives. As a child John was imprisoned in the Tower with his mother, but survived and married Joan Plantagenet, a great-granddaughter of Henry III via Henry (father) and Edmund (grandfather). He served against the Scots and died of the plague in 1361.*
