William purchased 1000- acre tract of land in Mansfield Township, Tolland County, Connecticut on 24 June 1695. He was appointed ensign of the company or trainband of Mansfield in 1704, lieutenant in 1714, captain in 1720. He served as a selectman for Mansfield in 1709/10 and in 1717 was a representative or deputy for the town of Mansfield.

William and Hester probably lived in Yarmouth, MA for several years before moving to Norwich and then Mansfield, CT. "Mansfield was settled from Windham in the 1690s and was known as Pond Place, after the small body of water just to the east of the old cemetery. As early as 1693 a committee was chosen to select a burying ground, with Captain William Hall agreeing to trade the cemetery plot for two acres elsewhere in town. Mansfield became a separate town in 1703."

Also, there is no record of a Frank Hall among children of Seth's siblings.
