Edmund Plantagenet, 1st Earl of Lancaster

B. 16 Jan 1244/1245 in London, England

D. 5 Jun 1296 in Bayonne, England.

M. **Blanche of Artois** in 1276 (2nd marriage after Aveline de Forz died)

Note: Crouchback means "crossed-back" and refers to participation in 9th Crusade

D. 22 Sep 1345 **Where?** (Blind about 1330 and spent final 15 months in Leicester Castle. Buried in Newarke Hospital Chapel. Remains later removed to Church of Annunciation of Our Lady of the Newarke.)

M. **Maud Chaworth** before March 2, 1296/1297

Children: Henry of Grosmont, 1st Duke of Lancaster; Blanche, Baroness Wake of Lidell, Maud, **Joan (Married John 3rd Baron Mowbray)**, Isabel, Eleanor, Mary

Note: Petitioned for title and land of executed older brother Thomas. Executed for part in rebellion against Edward II

B. 1312 in Grosmont Castle in Monmouthshire, Norfolk England

D. July 7, 1349 in Yorkshire England (**Buried at Byland Abbey**)

M. **John Mowbray, 3rd Lord Mowbray** (of Axholme Lincolnshire)

B. November 29, 1310 in Hovingham Yorkshire (SE of Thirsk)

D. October 4, 1361 in York. Buried in Friars Minor Bedford

Children: John, Blanche, Eleanor

NOTE: Joan was John's second of three wives. As a child John was imprisoned in the Tower with his mother, but survived and married Joan Plantagenet, a great-granddaughter of Henry III. He served against the Scots and died of the plague in 1361.

D. 1368 at 28 years of age near Constantinople on route to Holy Land
