Grandparents: Nicholas Phillips was born on 6 October 1611 at of Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. He was the son of Nicholas Phillips and Abigail Sewell. Nicholas Phillips married Elizabeth Jewson, daughter of Richard Jewson and Elizabeth Kipping, on 26 June 1631 at Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. Nicholas Phillips married Hannah Salter on 4 December 1651 at Boston, Suffolk, Massachusetts. Nicholas Phillips died on 1 September 1672 at Boston, Suffolk, Massachusetts, at age 60.

Nicholas Phillips was born in 1586 at Dedham, Essex, England. He was the son of Nicholas Phillips and (?) (?) Phillips. Nicholas Phillips married an unknown

person at Dedham, Essex, England. He died at of Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England.

Richard Jewson was born in 1582 at Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. He married Elizabeth Kipping on 29 October 1607 at Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England.

Abigail Sewell died Deceased at of Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. She married an unknown person at Dedham, Essex, England. She was born in 1588 at Dedham, Essex, England. She was the daughter of William Sewell and Margaret Gresebroke (Grazebrook).

Margaret Gresebroke (Grazebrook) married William Sewell at Dedham, Essex, England. Her married name was Sewell. Margaret Gresebroke (Grazebrook) was born in 1564 at of Dedham, Essex, England. She was the daughter of Alverey Gresebroke and Margaret Keene.

Alverey Gresebroke married Margaret Keene, daughter of Thomas Keene and (?) (?) Keene. Alverey Gresebroke was born in 1530 at of Middleton, Warwickshire, England. He was the son of John Gresebroke and Isabel (?) Gresebroke. Alverey Gresebroke died on 7 March 1576 at W/P.

Elizabeth Jewson was born in 1609/10 at of Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. She was the daughter of Richard Jewson and Elizabeth Kipping. Elizabeth Jewson married Nicholas Phillips, son of Nicholas Phillips and Abigail Sewell, on 26 June 1631 at Wendover, Buckinghamshire, England. As of 26 June 1631, her married name was Phillips. Elizabeth Jewson died in 1649 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.

Note: John Shaw was baptized on 23 May 1630 at Halifax, England.² He was the son of Abraham Shaw and Bridget Best.¹ John Shaw married Alice Phillips, daughter of Deacon Nicholas Phillips, circa 1650. John Shaw died on 16 September 1704 at Weymouth, Massachusetts, at age 74.² He [CR:]

JOHN SHAW, younger of the two sons of Abraham and Bridget (Best) Shaw, baptized in Halifax parish, Yorkshire, England, May 23, 1630, was in his ninth year when his father died. He grew up in Weymouth and married about 1650 Alice Phillips (daughter of Nicholas and Elizabeth Phillips of Dedham and Weymouth). He is credited with service under Lt. Upham as a soldier during King Philip's war, and was seventy-four years old when he died in Weymouth September 16, 1704. Administration of his estate was granted October 17, 1704 to his widow Alice, and to his eldest son John, Named in the distribution (March 11, 1705/6) were sons John, Nicholas, Joseph, Benjamin and Ebenezer, daughter Mary King (a widow) and her four sons, Joseph Poole and wife Elizabeth, Gideon Tirrel and wife Hannah, Richard Davenport and wife Abigail, John Androse and wife Alice. Elizabeth Poole was perhaps the Elizabeth Shaw

who signed as witness to the will of her grandfather, Nicholas Phillips, in 1671, if a girl of fifteen, as she was then, were allowed as witness.

John Whitmarsh , Jr

John Whitmarsh was baptized on March 3, 1624 in Shepton Mallet, Somerset, England. He was the son of John Whitmarsh and his wife, Alice, and came over from England with the Hull Company in 1635 on the ship *Marygould*. He was a Housewright and served in King Philip's War, in Captain Torrey's Company, in 1675. John married Sarah Harding, the daughter of John Harding, about 1654. He owned much property in Weymouth, Massachusetts as well as elsewhere. All of the above children were born in Weymouth. He was Housewright. He was born circa 1624 at England. He was the son of John Whitmarsh and Alice Garment. John Whitmarsh , Jr married Sarah Harding, daughter of John Harding, circa 1654 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.¹ John Whitmarsh , Jr died in 1709 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.

Sarah Harding was born in 1629 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts. She was the daughter of John Harding. Sarah Harding married John Whitmarsh , Jr, son of John Whitmarsh and Alice Garment, circa 1654 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.¹

Grandparents:

John Whitmarsh was born in 1595 at Weymouth, Dorset, England. He married Alice Garment before 1624; she was listed as already his wife when they arrived in 1635. John Whitmarsh immigrated on 20 March 1634/35 to Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts; John Whitmarsh came to American in 1635, at age 39. In his party were his wife Alice, age 35, and children John Jr. (11), Jane (7), Joseph (5) and Richard (2).^{1,2} He died circa 1644 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.¹

Alice Garment was born on 26 April 1607 at Batcombe, Somerset, England. She married John Whitmarsh before 1624; she was listed as already his wife when

they arrived in 1635. Alice Garment died in 1644 at Weymouth, Norfolk, Massachusetts.

NOTE: One of Judith and Joseph's children (Martha Shaw, born January 9, 1699/1700, married Eleazer Alden (3 generations descended from John and Priscilla Mullins Alden) with grandparents Joseph, Joseph, John.

Also, Abigail Shaw, daughter of Joseph and Judith, married Daniel Alden on December 25, 1717. Daniel B ALDEN was born 29 JAN 1691, and died 3 MAY 1767. He was the son of 24. Joseph Jr ALDEN and 25. Hannah DUNHAM.

Abigail SHAWSNOW was born 17 JUL 1695, and died 12 JUL 1755 in Stafford, Connecticut. She was the daughter of 26. Joseph SHAWSNOW and 27. Judith WHITMARSH.
