WHAT ACTIVITIES DOES THE CLUB ENGAGE IN?

The club's objectives are: Social, Literary, Civic, and Philanthropic.

To achieve these objectives, the club engages in several activities, such as:

1. Helping the Island Veterans through a fundraiser annually in October.
2. Working with the Island Grown Initiative Food Pantry to create recipes based on the items available in the pantry. This is a long-term project with the goal of creating a cookbook to serve as the basis for a fundraiser which may include a chef challenge event, for example.
3. Inviting local speakers from different organizations to inform us about their programs and their needs. Many members volunteer at non-profit organizations on the Island.
4. Recently we engaged with the MV High School students who created a Women's Club this past year. We have started to exchange our ideas and plan to help each other out. This is an intergenerational effort and we are all enjoying the benefits.

HOW DO I JOIN? HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

1. You may attend a meeting as a guest if you'd like. It's always a good idea to meet more members so you know this is an organization you can contribute to and benefit from. Just let us know in advance so we can make sure you know where the meeting will be held. When you are ready to join, you simply fill out a short application.

WHEN DO YOU MEET? AND WHERE?

2. We typically do not meet in the winter and during the summer we meet outside of Edgartown, sometimes at Farm Neck, and sometimes at a member's home.



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
