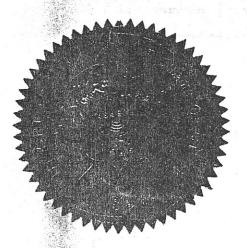

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FILLMORE WATER USERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

a Non-Profit Corporation

We, the undersigned persons do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the Statutes of the State of Utah.

T

NAME

The name of the corporation is Fillmore Water Users Association, Inc.

II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The Post Office address of the corporation's initial principal office is P.O. Box 686, Fillmore, Utah, 84631, and the Street address of the said office is 95 South Main, Fillmore, Millard County, Utah. The agent at such address shall be Paul McBride (DLA)

TTT

DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual.

IV

PURPOSES

This corporation is a nonprofit corporation. The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to deliver irrigation water to its stockholders at cost, and shall supply water to no one except its stockholders. The corporation shall not sell, distribute, or lend water for profit.

For this purpose and in aid thereof, the corporation shall have power to acquire, develope and operate water rights and water supplies in Millard

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County, Utah; to drill and equip wells; to construct, acquire and operate pumping plants, water storage andwater distributing systems; to purchase lease, or otherwise acquire and to own, hold, mortgage, pledge, sell and deal in real and personal property; to erect buildings and plants; to lend and borrow money; to execute mortgages, deeds of trust and pledges of real and personal property; and to do all other necessary or convenient things to accomplish the purpose of this corporation.

V CAPITALIZATION

The corporation shall have members, and shall issue shares of stock evidencing membership herein and an interest in water and other property rights. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue shall be Five hundred ten and forty nine/ one hundreds (510.49) shares. The corporation shall have the power to issue fractional shares when necessary. The said shares shall all belong to the same class to-wit common shares. Each share shall have the same preference, limitation and relative rights as all other shares. Provided however that fractional shares shall have that fractional preference, limitation and relative rights to which it is entitled.

VI ASSESSMENTS

The actual cost of management, development and operation of the business of this corporation shall be met by annual assessments on shares issued by the corporation.

The Board of Trustees shall annually determine whether or not to assess shares to pay the actual cost of management, development and operation of the business of this corporation.

Annual assessments shall be made on the basis of actual or estimated cost and expenses, including but not limited to loan principal and interest payments, maintenance, depreciation, labor and materials required for the purposes of this corporation. Assessments shall be equitably prorated between the shares of stock; provided however that the Board of Trustees

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shall have the power to make assessments against shares of stock on other than a prorated basis for the purpose of raising funds to accomplish the purpose or purposes for which this corporation is organized or to pay its debts or obligations, so long as the other than prorate assessments bears a reasonable relationship to the needs and requirments of the share or shares of stock so assessed.

Assessments, shall be made, processed, and enforced according to the assessment laws of the State of Utah, Title 16, Chapter 4, Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended through 1973 pocket supplement.

VII TRUSTEES

The number of trustees constituting the initial board of trustees of the corporation is five (5), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial trustees are:
