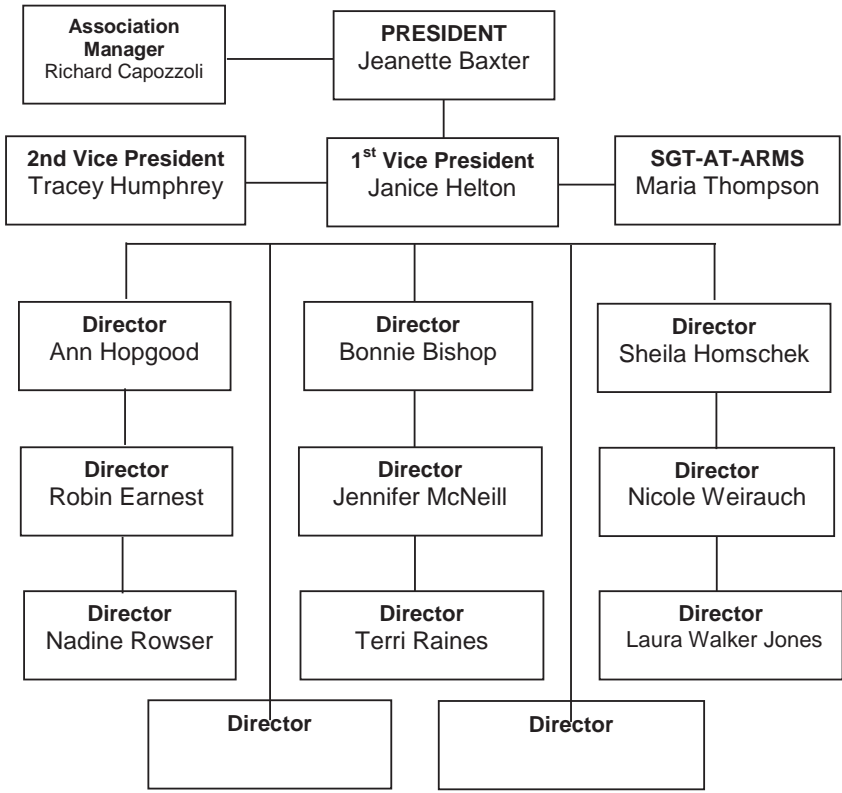

GENERAL INFORMATION

USBC/AUGUSTA USBC MEMBERSHIP

1. **REGULAR MEMBERSHIP**: A USBC membership purchased in a fall/winter league for the 2014-2015 season will be valid through July 31, 2015. Cards purchased in sanctioned 2015 summer leagues are valid only thru July 31, 2015. **Cost is \$17.00** (USBC \$10.00, Georgia State \$1.00, Local \$6.00). *Note: for definition of the types please contact the Augusta USBC/WBA Association Manager.*
2. **ADULT BASIC MEMBERSHIP**, for bowlers who compete in short season leagues that have 16 or fewer sessions. **Cost is \$11.00** (USBC \$7.00, Georgia State \$1.00, Local \$3.00) and membership ends at the end of the league. If a bowler wants to bowl in another short season league they have to purchase another adult basic membership \$11.00 or upgrade to the Regular membership of \$17.00.
3. **MULTIPLE MEMBERSHIP** (A USBC membership issued to an individual through another USBC Association): These individuals must show proof of their current USBC membership, valid only until the next August 1 date that occurs. Cost for an individual certification in Georgia is \$6.00 (Local Only) cost for an individual certified in another state \$7.00 (\$6.00 local, \$1.00 GA State).
4. **AUGUSTA USBC/WBA LOCAL LIFE MEMBERSHIP**: Members who have been awarded Local Life Membership by the AWBA will pay \$11.00 (USBC \$10.00, State \$1.00)

LEAGUE CERTIFICATION: The League Certification form must be filled in completely. Please use the checklist attached to the certification form. Be sure the two signatures required for bonding purposes are obtained. The certification form is due in the Association Manager's office within 30 days from the first day the League bowls.

PAYMENT OF CERTIFICATION & OTHER FEES: Payment to the Association should be by money order or check, **payable to the Augusta USBC/WBA**. Do not make checks out to USBC only. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT CASH IN THE DROP BOX**. Returned Check fees will be \$30.00 or equal to the banks return charge, whichever is greater.

AVERAGE REPORTS

Mid-Year Average: Mid-year average cut-off is December 31, 2014. Reports must be in the Association Manager's Office no later than January 10, 2015. The mid-year report must carry the same names as submitted on the individual certification application and must be alphabetical.

Final Averages: Final average cut-off is May 1, 2015. Reports must be in the Association Manager's Office no later than May 10, 2015. The final report must carry the same names as submitted on the individual certification application and must be listed alphabetically

*Note: If you need help with these reports, call your Lane Representative or any Augusta USBC/WBA Officer or Director. **Failure to comply with the above could result in formal action against the League President and Secretary.***

AWBA AWARDS PROGRAM

PURPOSE

To recognize all members of the Augusta USBC Women's Bowling Association for their accomplishments in games and series during bowling in a certified league.

QUALIFICATIONS

The Awards Program is based on the current season's average. A bowler may receive one award for games and one award for series in a classification per season. The secretary must hold awards for the bowlers until the bowler has 12 games in that league. If the score then qualifies after 12 games it should be forwarded to the awards committee/Association Manager. From then on the secretary will use the current average.

All applications for local AWBA awards must be submitted by the League Secretary to the Awards Committee on the application cards provided.

250 AND 650 PLAQUES

A bowler will receive only one plaque for 250 or better game and/or 650 or better series. The first year, plaque and add-ons will be given for all 250 games and 650 series bowled during the year. Thereafter, add-ons will be awarded with the year and all scores bowled. There will be two add-ons, one for games and one for series. Awards will be presented at the Annual Banquet.

700 PLAQUE

A bowler will receive a plaque for a 700 or better series. The first year a plaque and add-on will be given and thereafter, add-ons will be awarded with the year and all scores bowled. Awards will be presented at the Annual Banquet.

Final average report cut-off date is May 1, 2015. Reports must be turned in to the association no later than May 10, 2015.

This report must carry the same names as submitted on the individual certification application and must be listed alphabetically.

If final average reports are not received by the May 10, 2015 date, your bowler's average will not be printed in the yearbook.

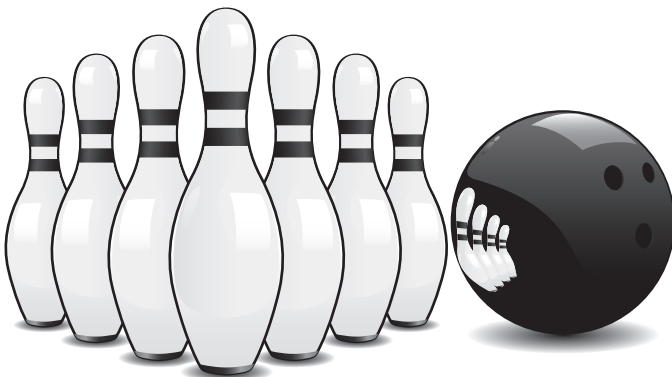

GENERAL INFORMATION

USBC/AUGUSTA USBC YOUTH MEMBERSHIP:

1. **REGULAR MEMBERSHIP:** A USBC membership purchased in a fall/winter league for the 2014-2015 season will be valid through July 31, 2015. Cards purchased in certified 2015 summer leagues are valid only thru July 31, 2015. **Cost is \$10.00** (USBC \$4.00, Local \$6.00 for purchase of Association Polo Shirt). The association will add an additional \$6.50 per certified bowler for the purchase of Association Polo shirts.
2. **LEAGUE CERTIFICATION:** The League Certification form must be filled in completely. Please use the checklist attached to the certification form. Be sure the two signatures required for bonding purposes are obtained. The certification form is due in the Association Manager's office within 30 days from the first day the League bowls.

PAYMENT OF CERTIFICATION & OTHER FEES: Payment to the Association should be by money order or check, **payable to the Augusta USBC Youth**. Do not make checks out to USBC only. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT CASH IN THE DROP BOX**. Returned Check fees will be \$25.00 or equal to the banks return charge, whichever is greater.

ALL STAR SELECTIONS

The All Star selections need to be turned in by April 1, 2015. This gives the association manager enough time to determine the winners and order the plaques in enough time to present them at the Year-End Bash.

AVERAGE REPORTS

The Augusta USBC Bowling Association is formed for these missions:

1. To promote and organize the sport of bowling both locally and in cooperation with other bowling groups locally, statewide and nationally.
2. To promote, organize, educate and service sanctioned leagues and sanctioned members within our jurisdictional area.
3. To promote, organize and run sanctioned tournaments for all our members in order to further sanctioned competition and the employment of our membership.

The Augusta USBC Bowling Association is the 4th oldest association in Georgia with its original sanction being granted January 13, 1943. For over 65 years the Augusta USBC Bowling Association has provided leadership in progress on behalf of, and for, both its members and the game of bowling. In 1949, the Augusta and Savannah Associations joined in forming the Georgia State Bowling Association in order to conduct annual State Tournaments. To date Augusta has hosted 9 Georgia State Championships and 3 Southeastern/SBA Tournaments. The ABA will host the upcoming 2009 SBA and the 2010 Georgia State Tournaments.

In 1987 A.B.C. recognized the Augusta USBC Bowling Association with its 5-year service award for outstanding service and commitment to Augusta's members. This was followed in 1992 by the A.B.C. 10-year service award and in 1993 by an award for outstanding publicity work. In 1994, the Augusta USBC Bowling Association was honored by the ABC as the recipient of the American Bowling Congress President's Award for outstanding service to its membership and to bowling. In 1997 ABC awarded the Augusta USBC Bowling Association its Continuing Service award, given to Presidential Award associations for their continuing commitment to excellence.

The Augusta USBC Bowling Association's delegates have provided key leadership in difficult times in representing Augusta at the Georgia State, Southeastern, and ABC/USBC National Conventions.

The Augusta USBC Bowling Association sponsors the City, Mixed City, and Seniors Tournaments for its members. It also works with the Bowler to Veteran's Link charity benefiting disabled Veterans. The AUSBCBA works as well with the Augusta USBC Women's Association and the Augusta USBC Youth in providing service to all bowlers of Augusta.

The following are SOME of the services the AUSBC BA provides to all members:

1. Inspects and certifies all bowling lanes annually.
2. Provides a local awards program to all members for their achievements.
3. Assigns a Director to every certified league.
4. Provides supplies and kits to every certified league.

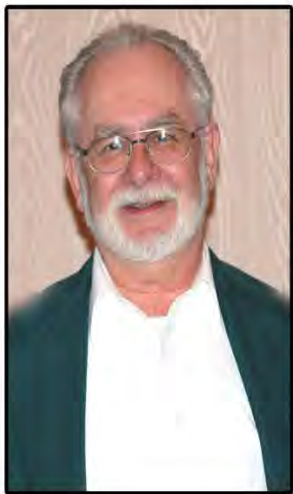

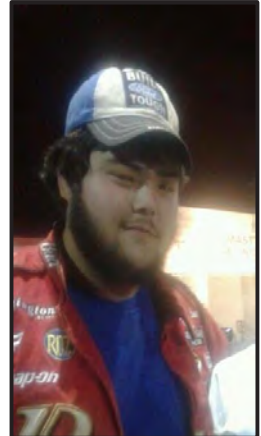

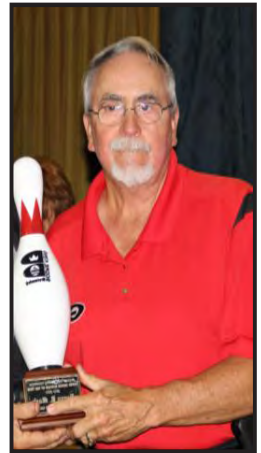

2. **FINAL AVERAGE** cutoff is May 1, 2015. Reports must be in the office of the Association Manager no later than May 1, 2015.

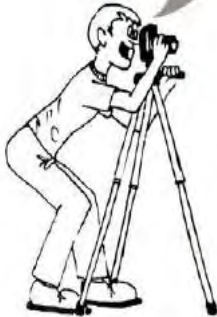

AUGUSTA USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

The purpose of this award is honor, pay tribute to and perpetuate the names of individuals who have contributed to the growth and welfare of the game of ten pin bowling through their ability as bowlers and/or their meritorious service to the AUSBCBA.

Membership in the AUSBCBA Hall of Fame shall be determined by an annual election described herein.

Nominations of candidates to the AUSBCBA Hall of Fame can be made by any sanctioned bowler of the AUSBCBA or members of the AUSBCBA Hall of Fame Screening Committee with the following stipulations:

1. All qualifications and achievements of the candidate prescribed hereafter, must accompany the nomination in writing.
2. All nominations must be forwarded, in writing, to the AUSBCBA Association Manager.
3. All nominations must be submitted no later than January 1 yearly.

The Screening Committee shall determine whether the candidates have exhibited the necessary qualifications. The following is a list of those qualifications:

1. A sanctioned bowler for at least 20 years in any association. At least 10 years must be in the AUSBCBA.
2. Possess an amiable personality.
3. Exhibit leadership qualities.
4. Show a sincere dedication to the sport of bowling.
5. Show achievement in the sport of bowling.
6. Bowled in at least 10 AUSBCBA tournaments.
7. Has provided outstanding service to the AUSBCBA and bowling.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

This award will be used to honor and pay tribute to those people or organizations who have distinguished themselves by providing outstanding service in support of bowling in the Augusta area. This award may be presented annually.

Any person or organization that has demonstrated outstanding ability or support to bowling in general in the Augusta area may be nominated for the Distinguished Service Award.

Any sanctioned bowler in the Association may nominate, in writing, a nominee for this award. All nominations must be submitted to the Association Manager of the AUSBCBA, no later than January 1 yearly. If no written nominee is submitted, a member of the Executive Committee may nominate a qualified candidate at their annual meeting.

Scholarship Program Requirement

Applicants must meet ALL of the following
eligibility requirements:

1. Must have been a member of USBC Youth at least three (3) years and presently be a member in good standing.
2. Must be a high school senior graduating this year, a high school graduate enrolled in college, or a college student the year the scholarship is awarded.
3. Must furnish a complete transcript of grades nine (9) through twelve (12), and if in college, a complete updated transcript of all college credits.
4. Must complete and submit an AUSBCBA College Scholarship Program Application Form along with recommendations from teachers, counselors, religious leader(s) and bowling coach(es) to the AUSBCBA.

Guidelines

- The AUSBCBA may award a scholarship to a boy or girl who meets the eligibility requirements.
- The AUSBCBA may present no more than 2 scholarships in the same year and not necessarily every year.
- The scholarship(s) shall be awarded with the approval of the AUSBCBA Scholarship Committee and the Board of Directors.
- The scholarship shall be paid directly to the selected college for tuition costs only. In the event the recipient of a scholarship decides not to enter college or has overextended the grace period, the scholarship shall revert to the AUSBCBA treasury and AUSBCBA shall NOT be required to select another recipient. Recipients of the award shall have a one (1) year grace period in which to make a decision.
