- Club Member achievements were applauded, and Session Leaders thanked.
- Club races thanks passed to Lyn Evans, Race Director and Debbie Williams, Volunteer Coordinator. Continued excellent feedback from participants of our races was applauded.
- Special mention to Sarah Lees for organising and running a P&D C25K programme that culminated with a P&D supported parkrun at Cosmeston Lakes. This will run again in the Spring, with assistance from other members (Simon, Colin, Mandy).
- Lyn noted there will be a parkrun club takeover at the end of March and a Run Wales social relay.
- Increased social media presence (Simon keeping Club visible on Instagram and Facebook). Club website continues to develop, noted high score on our platform provider GoDaddy with >53,000 visits in 2022.
- >£4,000 donated to charitable causes including Tenovus Cancer Care through the London Marathon place.
- Special mention to our late Club Member, Paul Whitmarsh. There will be a £1,000 cheque presentation to Paul's wife and son at the forthcoming Presentation Night (3rd March). £500 was kindly raised by club members and the amount matched from club funds. There will also be a presentation of the first Paul Whitmarsh Trophy for a particular marathon achievement.

LC subsidise their members at £3 per session)

- The success of Welsh Castles Relay was acknowledged, particular thanks to Kit for his ongoing hard work. Nigel Adams will investigate another multiparticipant team event for those not qualifying for Castles (WCR runners will also be welcomed).
