## GENERAL PARK RULES

★ ★ ★ ★

- Armstrong Park is a city owned park. Federal, state and local laws apply.
- Seasonal operation from April through October
- All tobacco use, including vaping, is prohibited on the sports complex grounds including the concessions area during play use.
- Animals are allowed but must be on a leash and 30 feet away from any playing field. Owners are responsible for animal waste.
- During athletic events, outside food and team tents are allowed but prearranged approval must be obtained.
