PROPOSITION K.I.D.S.

Shall the Board of Education of the Liberal R-II School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to replace roofs; to create a secure entrance at the Middle School/High School and enclose the hallway to the FFA classroom; to upgrade the Elementary School playground; to replace heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units District-wide; to update windows and interior doors at the Middle School/High School; to update windows at the Elementary School; to replace the hallway flooring at the Elementary School and Middle School/High School; to add Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible restrooms in the High School foyer; to replace exterior doors at the Elementary School; to update the football/softball concession stand and restrooms to add additional storage; to update electrical systems and the existing track; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
