# THE LAST SUPPER

People often treat Thanksgiving as a single moment. A day marked on the calendar once a year. But as Christians, we know that true gratitude is not meant to be seasonal; it is meant to be lived. The Last Supper itself reminds us that thanksgiving was at the very heart of Jesus' fellowship with His disciples, not as an annual event but as a daily expression of surrender and love. Brother Branham spoke the same truth when he said that Thanksgiving should not be confined to one holiday but should flow from our lives every day as a continual offering to God.

He reminded believers that real thanksgiving is shown through the life we live, the humility we carry, and the gratitude we express in every circumstance. In a time when many people forget the purpose behind the blessings they enjoy, we as message believers are called to stay grateful, to live every day with the consciousness that God has provided for us, protected us, and sustained us. Thanksgiving, then, is not about a table filled with food. It is about a heart filled with praise.

As message believers, we believe in praying without ceasing; gratefulness is what keeps you connected. In his message "Hear Ye Him" (1960), he reminded believers that true worship comes from recognizing God in every circumstance and offering thanks continually. Not only when life is easy, but also when the road becomes difficult. He emphasized that a grateful heart keeps a believer in the presence of God, teaching that the Holy Spirit works through those who remain humble and thankful. And in "It Is I, Be Not Afraid" (1960), he encouraged believers to thank God before the answer comes, because faith believes God is already at work. What he started he will finish!

These teachings support the truth that thanksgiving is not a holiday meal but a lifestyle. When we walk in daily gratitude, thanking God for breath, strength, mercy, and grace, we step into the same spirit Jesus demonstrated at the Last Supper, offering thanks even as He faced the cross. Brother Branham's messages make it clear.
