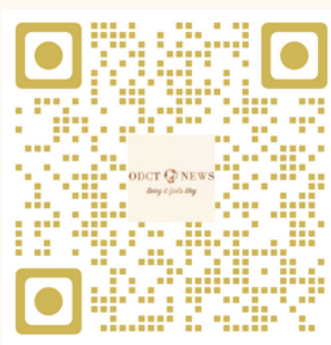

Beyond the Bunny: The True Message of Easter

As Easter came and went, so has people's understanding of its true meaning. To some, Easter simply means a time for egg hunts and celebrating the Easter Bunny. The Easter Bunny tradition originated in Germany, with German immigrants bringing the idea of the "Osterhase" or "Easter Hare" to the United States in the 1700s. This custom likely evolved from pagan beliefs about spring and fertility, where hares were symbols of new life. In fact, the Easter Bunny can be traced back to a pagan goddess named Eostre, associated with spring and fertility, whose symbol was the hare. Over time, the tradition shifted into the Easter Hare—an egg-laying creature who would hide colorful eggs for children to find. But the question remains: What does the Easter Bunny truly have to do with Easter?

For Christians, Easter means resurrection. We believe Easter is not just one day a year to celebrate the fact that Jesus rose from the grave—it is a daily reality. It's not only that He rose and went to heaven, but that He is alive and living in us right now. Many Christians claim to believe in the resurrection, but fail to recognize that Jesus has returned in Spirit, dwelling within His people and working through His Church. In a message by Br. Branham titled *Sirs, We Would See Jesus*, Br. Branham says "When Jesus rose from the dead, God justified, justifies us by faith, believing that, that God rose Him up from the dead; and we are waiting for the rapture which will come. Everything will happen in its season." This quote reflects what many believers are now proclaiming—the time of restoration has come.

And in this season, the true meaning of Easter is not found in a symbol, but in a risen Savior made manifest through His people.
