The Token: It's Meaning, Message, and Power

In the world, a token is simple and practical. It is proof that a fare has been paid, a small object given after payment that grants access to a train, a bus, or an event. Without it, no matter how close you are to the door, you cannot enter. A token cannot be exchanged for anything else, reused for another purpose, or replaced by good intentions. It serves one function alone.

This familiar idea helps illuminate what the Token means in the Message. Brother Branham taught that “the Token is the Holy Ghost, the literal Life of Jesus Christ returned back into the believer”. He emphasized that you cannot spend it on anything else, for the only thing God recognizes is the Token He requires. This truth is made real through the testimonies of Message believers who have received the Holy Ghost.

One such testimony is seen in how ODCT received Brother Earl, fulfilling Brother Branham's statement that the Spirit must return back into the Church. When Brother Earl first came to ODCT, he shared how the Lord personally directed his steps, showing him where to go and how to build the church, Wildwood Tabernacle. These testimonies help us see that the Token is real and still working today. As the world is going crazy and everything around us is shaking, the question becomes personal. Do you have the Token?

✧ God Confirming Brother Earl Martin's Testimonies ✧

During the Boston meetings in August 2021, Br. Earl Martin was getting ready to preach and had asked Br. Cary Holden, from Wildwood Tabernacle, to print out a certain quote of Br. William Branham for him. However, as Br. Earl looked for the quote, he thought the quote was placed in his bible, but he was unable to locate it. He asked the Assistant Pastor of Open Door Community Tabernacle, Br. Kenol Helas, to go get the quote from Br. Cary in the back. As the quote was handed to Br. Earl, he opened his bible and placed it in there to read to the congregation later. As Br. Earl ministered to the people, he had not read the quote as yet. Then the Holy Spirit started moving and fell upon a sister and she begins to prophesy:

He! He! He! He! He! He! Oh, He! He! He! He! I tell you, I tell you, He! He! He! He! You watch, you watch, you watch, you watch. The fruits, the fruits, the fruits, the fruits of your testimonies, of your testimonies, of your testimonies. I tell you He! They are not just yours. They are mine, mine, mine, mine. And I tell you, I tell you, I tell you my people, if you doubt these testimonies, if you doubt these testimonies, I tell you, you doubt me, you doubt me. I tell you, I tell you, I tell you my people, for these are mine, mine, mine, mine, mine mine. I tell you, I tell you, I tell you.

After the Holy Spirit finished using the sister, Br. Earl said, "Now, listen. Look what He said, These are my testimonies. I got something right here in my bible that I was going to read to you, but now the Holy Spirit has done spoke it. It said if a man goes forth-- Br. Branham said, with testimonies, and they are-- God vindicates them testimonies, then they are no longer his testimonies, they are My testimonies. They are God's testimonies, and I will read that quote to you, but I don't have to because the Holy Ghost just called it out, the very words I was going to read to you tonight. But I didn't even have to read it to you because the Holy Ghost told you. These are not, these are not Earl Martin's testimonies. These are vindicated God's testimonies. Well, I think I'm just going to let you people read it:

"Then you have to notice. When you testify of something, if God... If a man testifies, you have a right to doubt that (See?), or not doubt it, but to watch it. And then if God testifies to the same thing, that it's absolutely the truth, then that's not the man's testimony, that's God confirm-ing that testimony. Isn't that right?"

That is God confirming it and it's no longer the man's testimony. Wasn't that exactly what the Holy Spirit spoke right here? That is why I want to read it to you because I want to show you the Holy Ghost. I told you He is here, right here in our midst, now, and you can get deliverance if you want deliverance. You can get deliverance."

God permitted Br. Cary to forget the quote so all the Glory can go to Him and prove once more that He is alive in our midst.

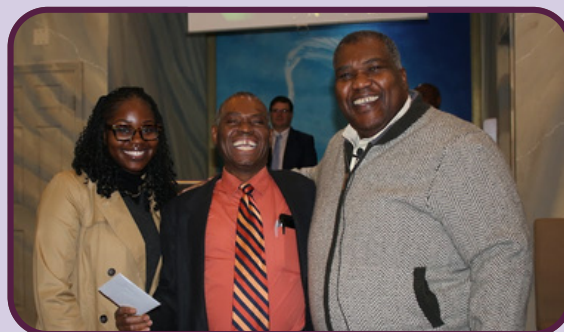

NEW YEAR'S TESTIMONY

In 2021, just a few weeks before the ODCT Annual Meetings, our dear Sister Kar Raphino from Idaho had a strong desire to attend the meetings. At that time, she had been suffering greatly from an ongoing sickness that doctors could not diagnose. Some doctors said it was cancer, others claimed it was a mental condition and prescribed antidepressants, and at one point she was even told she had only 24 hours to live.



In the midst of this trial, Sis. Kar contacted her cousin, Bro. Edmond Raphino, and shared her weariness and pain. She told him she was tired of the sickness and was crying out to God for healing. She said that if she were going to die, she wanted to die in Boston because she believed that if she could make it there, God would heal her. Little did she know, God had already heard her cry.

On **August 1, 2021**, a few weeks before the ODCT Annual Meetings, the Holy Spirit spoke through a vessel, saying that he had heard His daughter's cry. The message revealed that he would take action, move on her behalf, and make her testimony not only a witness to her husband and children, but to the entire congregation.

By God's grace, Sis. Kar was able to travel to the meetings with her daughter, Sarah. However, when Satan sees that someone is a child of God, he often tries to disrupt God's plan. During the meetings, Sis. Kar became very ill; she was weak, unable to eat, and began vomiting. Yet as a believer, she called upon the elders of the church to pray for her, asking God to remove the spirit that had been troubling her and to reveal the cause of her suffering once she returned to Idaho.



Just as the church prayed, when Sis. Kar returned home, doctors discovered a tumor on her pancreas. She immediately underwent emergency surgery. Today, Sis. Kar stands as a living testimony, giving God all the glory for keeping His promise and healing
