And that's what's the matter with the world today: there's too much seminary experiences, too much placed upon education, too much placed upon relationship or fellowships in denomination, we rest on one another, we rest upon men with ability. The Bible said, "How can you have faith when you—when you are..." Let's see, how is that Scripture? "How can you have faith when you're preferring one another?" When we are expecting, saying, "This guy, he's a great person. This is a great person, I'll just lean upon him," that displeases God when you do that. We must lean upon God and God alone! We mustn't trust the ability of ourselves or any man. We must completely yield to God.

Saint Patrick Was Not A Catholic

Saint Patrick's Story: This excerpt from *An Exposition of the Seven Church Ages* by Rev. William Marrion Branham, specifically from "The Thyatirean Church Age", contrasts Saint Patrick with Rome's claims about him. While the messenger for this church age was Saint Columba, Bro. Branham highlights Patrick's life to refute the idea that he was aligned with the Roman Catholic Church.

Originally named Succat, Patrick was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Northern Ireland, where he worked as a swineherd and became a skilled dog trainer. Through his faith, he was saved and later orchestrated a clever escape using his trained dogs. After returning home, he attended Bible school and eventually returned to Ireland, where he led thousands to Christianity through preaching and miracles.

Contrary to Roman Catholic claims, Patrick never sought Rome's approval or operated under its commission. Later, when Rome gained influence in Ireland, they persecuted and killed over 100,000 Christians who had emerged from Patrick's teachings.

As message believers, we understand that Saint Patrick was not a Catholic but a true Christian. We do not celebrate Saint Patrick's Day because it was created by the Catholic Church. Instead, we recognize that Rome has distorted the true history of Saint Patrick to fit its own agenda. Just as Patrick stood apart from the religious system of his time, we are called to separate ourselves from the world and its traditions that do not align with the Word of God.

This is why we look to our prophet, Bro. William Branham, to guide us in the right path and lead us back to the true Gospel. Through his ministry, we are reminded not to conform to the world but to follow the unchanging Word of God, remaining true to the faith once delivered to the saints.
