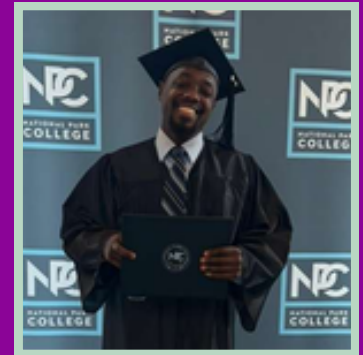

As the spring rain settles, we are reminded of a simple truth: April showers bring May flowers. But there is a deeper mystery in the garden. The rain falls on every inch of soil alike, it pours on the weeds just as heavily as it pours on the lilies. The rain provides the moisture, but it is the seed that determines the life that emerges.

Brother Branham captured this perfectly when he said:

Br. Bastien is still holding down the fort in Haiti spreading the message everywhere he goes.

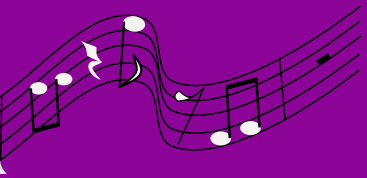

Br. Julio continues to lead and guide the local congregation, nurturing a thriving community of faith.

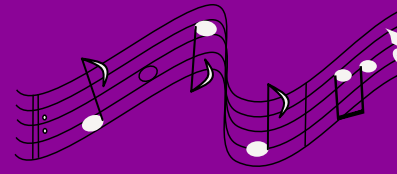
