# TILL WE MEET AGAIN

## Br. Thomas Brady

Today, we pause with both gratitude and reverence as we remember our dear Brother Brady, who went to be with the Lord on **March 9th at 4:00 PM**. While our hearts feel the weight of his passing, we rejoice knowing that his life was a living testimony of God's faithfulness and power.



Brother Brady was blessed with a rare and precious opportunity to be present in the meetings of God's prophet, William Marrion Branham, during the year 1965. Like our Brother Earl Martin, he personally witnessed the moving of the Holy Spirit in those meetings and experienced the grace of God in a remarkable way. He often shared how he longed to meet the "Martin boys" because of how much Brother Branham spoke of them. In the perfect timing of God, that desire was fulfilled during the 2019 Revival in Jamaica, where he was able to meet them in person, truly a special and ordained moment.

During one of those meetings, Brother Brady carried a deep burden in his heart for his wife who was in Jamaica. She suffered from a serious condition that caused her feet to swell greatly, bringing discomfort and concern to their family. Though Brother Brady had not spoken to anyone about this burden, it was a silent prayer within his heart.

But the Lord, who knows the secrets of every heart, moved in that meeting. Without ever knowing Brother Brady personally or hearing his request, Bro. William Marrion Branham called him out from the crowd and spoke directly to the need that was in his heart. In that moment, the prophet declared the promise of God concerning his wife.

**"Here is a colored man sitting way back here, got a burden on his heart. It's for his wife. She is not here, even. She's got trouble with her feet. You believe that He'll heal her? You do? You're a stranger here. You're from across the sea. You're from Jamaica. Do you believe God can tell me who you are? Mr. Brady. You believe? Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."**

Brother Brady believed the Word spoken over him.

In those days, there were no phones readily available, so he wrote a letter back home to Jamaica, telling his wife about the prayer and the promise that had been spoken over her.

When his wife received the letter, she began reading it. As she finished reading, she happened to look down at her feet, and to her amazement, the swelling was completely gone. Her feet had returned to normal.



What a testimony of the living God who keeps His promises.

Brother Brady carried this testimony for many years, reminding us that when God speaks, His Word does not fail. His life stood as a witness of faith, humility, and trust in the promises of the Lord.

Today we say farewell to our beloved brother, but we do not say goodbye forever. We hold firmly to the promise that we will meet again.

Brother Brady fought a good fight, kept the faith, and finished his course. With grateful hearts we say:

God be with you till we meet again, Brother Brady.

His testimony will continue to strengthen the faith of the saints and remind us all that God is still faithful to His Word.


