

## I Am The True Vine

As message belivers we are all familiar with the scripture in **John 15: 1** "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman." and **John 15: 5** "I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." If you haven't realized it yet, Jesus Christ is the true vine, and we (the Bride) are the branches. We must carry the same life and produce the same spirit as Christ. Just as a branch receives its life from the vine, our spiritual life and strength come only by remaining fully connected to Him. That connection isn't just believing in Him—it's abiding in Him daily through prayer, the Word,



So as believers, we must take this to heart and ask ourselves: is the life of the Vine continuing in us, the branches? Are our lives reflecting His Word, His character, and His Spirit? The life of the Vine has to be in the branches, or else we are not truly connected to Him.





**Bro. John Fletcher**
