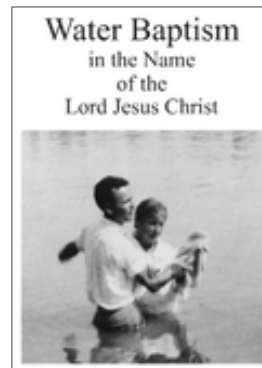


Br. Jefferey baptizing people in Ghana under the name of our Lord Jesus Christ

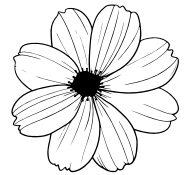
