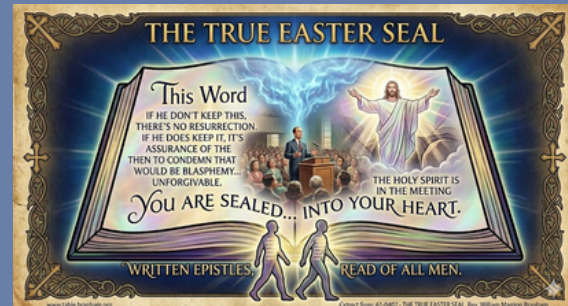

The purpose of Jesus’ death on the cross was to pay the price for our sins, yet we often find ourselves pulling away from Him. As Br. Naully Jean-Francois emphasized during the Texas Easter Revival, we are not called to stop at the cross; we must go through the cross. Many remain at the place of sacrifice but never step into the life-changing power it unlocked.

That journey leads us into the resurrection the power that restores. Br. Edmonds highlighted this in his three-part Easter message, showing that restoration is a return to the original Word: understanding the sacrifice, walking in the power, and living out the manifestation. 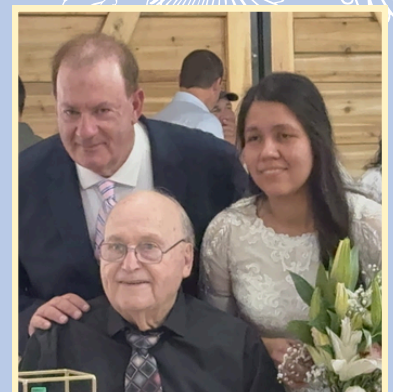

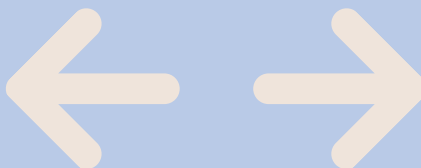

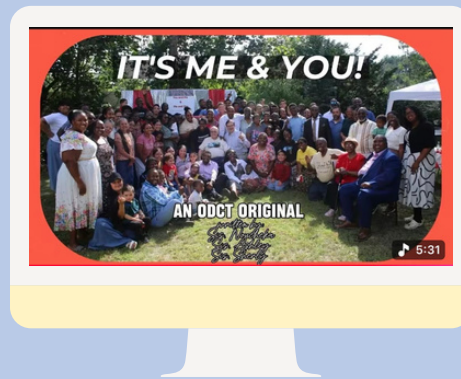
