



TOOLGRID BOARD SET UP INSTRUCTIONS




Be sure to keep the non-slip liner suppied with your toolchest in place. This will prevent the toolgrid board from sliding around.

Determine which Toolgrid board(s) are closest to the drawer dimensions. Extra wide drawers will require two Toolgrid boards.



Determine the final "cut down" board size and mark the cut lines on the Toolgrid board. To cut away the excess material it is recommended that you use a jig saw with a fresh cutting blade.



For the best results, it is recommended that the board be cut between two rows of holes. If needed, cut the board slightly smaller than your measurement.

(4) Place the Toolgrid board(s) into the drawer. You are now ready to organize your tools.
