- The Board received a \$5,000 quote to revamp the front entrance but is not moving forward at this time due to limited funding and no existing irrigation system. The Board is currently getting quotes to install irrigation first.
- The HOA also received a \$1,000 quote for a community announcement sign (installation not included). This project is not included in the current budget, and the Board discussed budgeting for this next year as future funding allows.
- The lawncare vendor is addressing the known ant issue, and two treatments have been applied.
