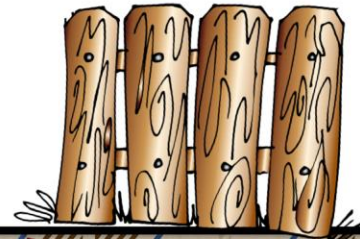




4TH GRADE ROUND-UP JANUARY 24, 2022



Reading:

We will explore a biography of Lincoln and identify important characteristics in his life. We will also learn how to conduct a biographical interview. The students will be interviewing a family member, gathering interesting facts about his/her life. They will bring home a form next week that they will use to organize their information. This will be **due next Wednesday, February 2**. Reading Journals are **due on Tuesday**.

English:

The students will learn about possessive pronouns this week and how to identify common contraction errors with pronouns.

Spelling:

Bible:

We will study Jacob and then turn our attention to Joseph and how God turned the trials in his life into blessings.



History: From our text, we will study Taoism, the Great Wall of China and the Terra-cotta Warriors. Two new timeline events will be added: D-Day (1944) and the explosion of the Challenger (1986). Those missing more than five on last week's geography test will take it again on Friday.

Science: We are continuing our study of the moon and its phases. There will be a quiz on Friday. This week the students will receive information on two options for the Chapter 7 assessment. They will either 1) make a model of an area of the moon's surface or 2) take the written test. The **due date** on this is **Tuesday, February 1**.

Math: We continue to study geometric figures. On Thursday, we will have a special session on how to use Chromebook tools in preparation for ILEARN. At the end of the week, we will make a fun polygon art project. The Chapter 7 test will be on **Wednesday, February 2**.
