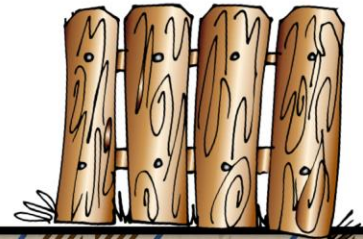




4TH GRADE ROUND-UP JANUARY 4, 2022



Reading:

The fourth graders will explore poetry this week. We will read and identify onomatopoeias (sound effects) in poetry and explore shape poems. The students will illustrate their onomatopoeias and work on writing their own shape poems. If the students chose to do the optional journal over Christmas Break, it is due on Tuesday.

They only need to turn in their minutes. They do not need to write a journal. They will receive a new journal in their Tuesday folders.

English:

We will begin a unit on pronouns this week. Our focus is on identifying pronouns and finding object and subject pronouns in sentences.

Spelling:

There is no Spelling test this week. We will have one over List 17 next Wednesday.



Science:

This week we are beginning a study on the human eye. We will identify each part of the eye and its function, learn how light travels through the eye, and differentiate between concave and convex lenses. There is a **quiz on Friday**.

Math:

We will begin the year with a STEAM activity. On Thursday we will start Chapter 7 which focuses on Geometry.



History:

We are beginning a chapter on ancient China this week. We will make a raised relief map out of clay as a class project. Our new timeline event is the California Gold Rush of 1848. The students will learn the key countries of Africa and have a **quiz on Friday**.

Bible:

We will learn about the Biblical patriarch, Joseph, this week. From his life we will learn how God can take a prideful deceiver and transform him into a humble servant. If we are willing, He can change us and use us for His glory. Memory verse **quiz on John 1:12 is on Friday**.
