Math, Science, & History:

- Math:** We will begin the week reviewing addition and subtraction of fractions and mixed numbers. Next, we will start a new topic: addition and subtraction of decimals.
- Science:** We will continue in space with our next chapter and move from stars to the solar system.
- History:** The students will study the first battles of the Revolutionary War at Lexington and Concord and come to appreciate the role that Paul Revere played in his infamous "midnight ride." Language Arts & Bible:
