Math, Science, & History:

- **Math:** We will continue with our Geometry chapter. We will work on measuring angles, drawing angles, and classifying triangles. We will be doing the checkpoint #3 retest on Friday.
- **Science:** We will finish our Genetics/Heredity chapter this week. We will start the week completing our "Paper Pet Genetics" activity and then we will work on lesson #5 which is the last lesson of the chapter. Throughout the week, we will also be working on the study guide for the Science test on Friday. Students have been filling out a sheet during each lesson, and those sheets are able to be used on the test!
- **History:** The history students will continue to learn one Washington, DC landmark per day. They will be quizzed on these eventually. We will also discuss Thomas Jefferson and the exploration of Lewis and Clark. In our timeline unit on the Civil War, we will briefly outline the battles and focus on Gettysburg and Lincoln's famous address.

Language Arts, Bible, & History:

- **Reading and English:** We will take the iLearn practice tests this week on Tuesday and Wednesday. During the rest of our time, we will review various English skills as well as work on editing, typing, and sharing our persuasive essays.
- **Jar of Books:** Students are reading fictional chapter books this month. They will identify the theme and mood on their response bookmarks. As a reminder, the students are required to read at least one book (of 100 pages or more) per month for the Jar of Books.
- **Word Study:** Test over List #23 will be on Tuesday.
- **Bible:** Our Bible time will be limited this week due to testing, but the students will **memorize 1 Cor. 13:5** for their test on Friday.

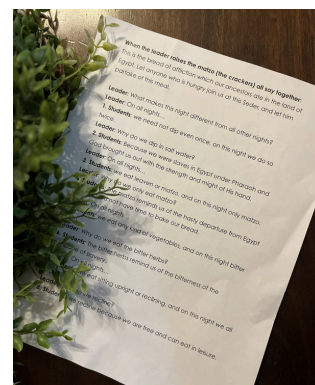
