April 9-12, 2024

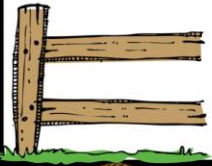


Reading: On Tuesday, the students will have their vocabulary test. On Wednesday and Thursday, the students will have their official practice testing for ILEARN.

Reading Journals: The white, read-only journal is due on Tuesday when we return.

English: We will review types of writing and various English concepts in addition to taking the ILEARN practice tests.

Spelling: The students will take their test over list 27 on Tuesday. Due to ILEARN testing the week of the 15th, we will have no new spelling words to study.



History: The students will discover what the ancient Greeks thought about gods, goddesses and philosophers. We will analyze some Aesop's fables together.

In our review of US geography, we will begin to focus on the location of the midwestern states.

Science: The students will learn about biomimicry and begin a STEAM project that will be due on April 19.

Math: The students will have two days of iLEARN practice testing this week. We will also talk about divisibility rules for multiples of 2, 5, and 10 and review the concepts we have learned in this chapter on long division.
