Reading: This week our focus is on the heroes of September 11th, 2001. We will participate in a webcast in the auditorium on Monday where we will hear interviews from first responders and others who displayed heroic acts on this day in history. We will also read stories this week centered around various viewpoints of 9/11.

History: The students will commemorate 9-11 by attending a special video with interactive capability from the National 9-11 Museum on Monday. We will compare the Epic of Gilgamesh to the biblical account of the Flood and Hammurabi's Code with the Mosiac Law. Ninevah, the capital of Assyria, is also a focus of our chapter.

The students will be tested on the dates for our first four timeline events and also the location and flags of 4 North American and 5 South American countries on Friday.

Science: The students will begin the week investigating how temperature affects the movement of water in a plant. They will also learn more about important uses for plants.

Math: On Monday the students will have a STEAM activity focusing on design and budgeting. After taking the Chapter 1 test which was postponed from last week to allow for further review, they will begin Chapter 2, adding numbers with up to 5 digits.

Bible: This week we will wrap up our discussion of the events of Creation and learn about the Fall and its effects on the world then and today.
