Weekly Verse

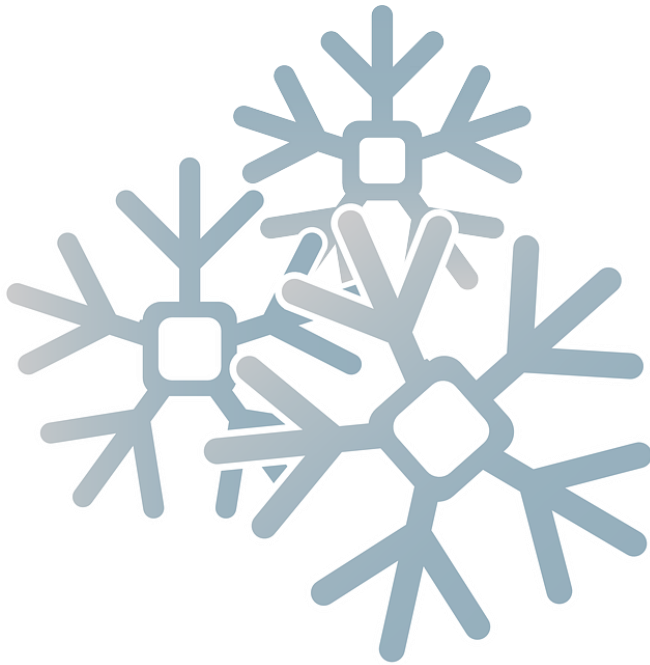


I Samuel 15:22b
