This is what we will be working on in K4 this week.

- ♣ As we wrap up our unit on literature, we will be talking about the library. If you have not done so already, this would be a great time to get your child a library card. There are so many great resources the library offers. You should take advantage of those resources.
- ♣ This week we will have introduced all the letters. Now we will go back through each letter more in depth. We will also be working on writing each letter. As I introduce each letter again, I will be sending home flash cards with each child. Go through those flash cards at home. The more review and one on one attention each child receives, the more success each child will see in the classroom.
- ♣ We continue to work on numbers, letters, and colors. The flashcards that I send home will also contain numbers, colors, and shapes.
- ♣ In the next couple of weeks, I will be starting assessments for each child. This is a measure of where each child is. The assessments will let you see what your child can do and areas that will need additional work. I will use these assessments to adjust my teaching as well.
