

## WHAT WILL OUR CLASSROOM LOOK LIKE?

#### CLASSROOM PROCEDURES

I will be using Class Dojo for recording positive student behavior. Students may use their positive points to earn and redeem Classroom Coupons throughout the week. I will be using a Logical Consequence system for discipline. Students will receive a logical consequence for the behavior that needs to be corrected. Instances that require discipline will be opportunities to connect with your child and teach them about the love of Christ.

# HOMEWORK Student assignment pads will be ser

Student assignment pads will be sent home every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday and must return the following day. Daily assignment pads must be signed by the parent/guardian each night after completing the assignment. Homework will include 10 minutes of reading each night and requires a Reading Log to be filled out. It may also include test study, math review, or writing assignments.

#### NEWSLETTER
