The first step is to download the Box Tops app. As you create your account, you are able to choose the school of your choice. When you purchase something with the digital Box Top logo, you have fourteen days to scan your receipt. That simply involves taking a picture of your receipt so that the retailer, date, product info, and bar code are all visible. After your picture has been taken, there is a star button to credit the proper class with the amount (either the grade level or teacher name). The only thing left to do is select the "submit" button!
