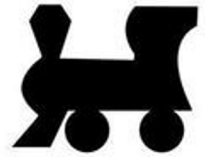

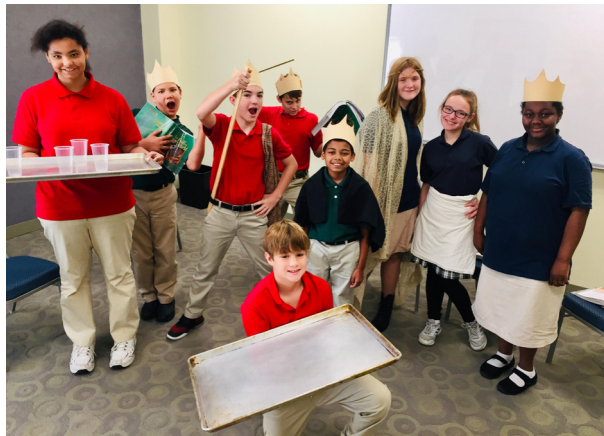
READING
