### Math, Science, & History:

- **Math:** We will continue calculating area and perimeter. We will focus on the area of triangles, trapezoids, parallelograms, and complex shapes. ILEARN Checkpoint #2 retakes are finished, and the reports will come home on Tuesday. Be on the lookout to see how your child is doing with current Mathematics concepts.
- **Science:** The Science test is on Tuesday. We will then spend Wednesday finishing up our "Planetgram" project. Projects will be presented to the class on Thursday.
- **History:** The history students will have a test on the Revolutionary War on Wednesday, February 18. They were given a study sheet this past Wednesday. On Thursday, they will view a movie on Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. Then, we will begin a study of the Constitution and the Bill of Rights.

### Language Arts & Bible:

- **Reading:** This week, the fifth graders will work on identifying claims and evidence in advertisements and other texts. The students will learn to be observant and critical of what ads claim as fact in order to make informed decisions.
- **English:** We will continue writing our poems for the grandparents. These poems will be read aloud on Grandparents Day on Friday!
