### Math, Science, & History:

- **Math:** We will finish the chapter this week over adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers. The chapter test will be on Monday, November 24th.

We will be working on the project Wednesday (11/19), Thursday (11/20), and Friday (11/21). The presentations will be Monday (11/24) and Tuesday (11/25).
- **History:** We have just begun our study of colonists with an independent spirit. Collectively, they will rise up to demand their independence from England. We are trying to understand the French and Indian War and how it also paved the way for the future United States.
