Participants will tour the production line by golf cart and finish with hands-on experience in the F-35 Cockpit Demonstrator Simulator (CDS). Additionally, LM Aero is coordinating to have their F-35 Cockpit Demonstrator established in our Ready Room, allowing "Hands-On" demo of how the cockpit is configured along with a visual of how the F-35 handles & employs its weapons. *This tour has a maximum capacity of 40 guests.*
