

Mr. Gabe,

The following is a timeline similar to what we presented to you and your family on Friday. I have included dates, times, locations, and sources of the information. This information was determined based on cell phone records, a forensic download of Alexis' Infinity that included GPS locations, forensic cell phone extractions, surveillance video, and interviews. The calculations for distance are based on rough measurements and are not a final analysis of speeds, distances, or times.

Note: Text in **RED** are added by the Gabe Family.

January 26, 2022

- 1/26/22 around 6:00 PM, Alexis' friend stated she was on a Facetime call with her, and Alexis appeared to be in her car in her parking lot.
- 1/26/22 around 6:22 PM, Alexis pulled into the Chevron at 5591 Lone Tree Wy. Her cell phone records, Infinity GPS, and surveillance video placed her there.
- 1/26/22 around 6:29 PM, Alexis left the Chevron according to her cell phone records, Infinity GPS, and surveillance video.
- 1/26/22 around 6:37 PM, Alexis arrived at Marshall's house on Benttree Wy. She passed several surveillance cameras from Chevron to Marshall's house. Her Infinity turned off at 6:37:30 PM. Her phone continued to be on and active and showed to be in the same area. There is no video footage of her arriving at Marshall's house.
- 1/26/22 at 9:10:24 PM, Marshall's device began a 1-hour, 59-minute call to his father.
- 1/26/22 at 9:20:27 PM, Marshall's device logged the last "lift to wake." (As previously discussed, iPhones log every time the phone lights up after sensing motion).

- 1/26/22 around 9:23:59 PM, Alexis' Infinity turned on and began moving. Her cell phone also moved along with the Infinity GPS. The Infinity passed several cameras during its travel. The Infinity drove out to Lone Tree Wy and turned eastbound. The Infinity turned south on Jeffrey Wy and got onto WB SR-4. The Infinity exited WB SR-4 onto Laurel Rd. It drove EB Laurel and turned NB onto Live Oak Av. It made the NB turn onto Live Oak Av at Neroly Rd and continued to drive NB on Live Oak Av. It turned EB onto Gum Tree Rd and drove about 200 feet before turning around back WB on Gum Tree Rd. It turned NB onto Live Oak Av again. It turned EB onto Oakley Rd then finally SB onto Trenton St where it parked on the west curb line.

(Historical data from the GPS showed Alexis drove a specific way to Antioch and back to her house. There were no deviations from the route until this trip, which was not the usual way Alexis usually drove from Antioch to Oakley.)

- 1/26/22 around 9:35:45 PM, the Infinity turned off. Seconds later, the driver exited the vehicle and walked NB on Neroly Rd. No other person exited the vehicle. Alexis' cell phone records showed the device moving along with the person who exited the car.
- 1/26/22 around 9:39:49 PM, the driver of the Infinity passes surveillance cameras at Oakley Rd/Beldin Ln. Four minutes is the time it would take the average person to walk this distance (about 950 feet).
- 1/26/22 around 9:43:30 PM, Alexis' phone stopped transmitting data and was presumably turned off. Her phone records showed to be along the same path as the driver of the Infinity.
- 1/26/22 around 10:06:22 PM, the presumed driver is captured on surveillance video at Live Oak Rd near Neroly Rd. This is about 1.17 miles from Oakley Rd/Beldin Ln and about 26-minutes 29-seconds after the driver was captured on video at the intersection. This is the time it would take an average person to walk this distance. Video showed the person continuing south on Live Oak Rd, crossing Neroly Rd, and continuing under the Laurel overpass.

- 1/26/22 around 10:37:46 PM, the driver is captured on surveillance video at the Slatten Ranch Shopping Center. He walked along the paved foot path behind the shopping center that parallels SR-4. This was about 1.17 miles from Live Oak Rd/Neroly Rd and 31-minutes and 23-seconds after the last video. This is the time it would take for an average person to walk this distance.
- 1/26/22 around 10:43 PM, video from Chase Bank at Lone Tree Wy/Jeffrey Wy showed the driver walking across Lone Tree Wy from north to south and walk WB on the southern sidewalk of Lone Tree Wy. Video from Lowes showed this person walking into the Chevron parking lot (5591 Lone Tree Wy). Chevron video showed the subject walking WB through the shopping center. Video from In and Out showed the subject walking through the shopping center parking lot.
- 1/26/22 around 11:03 PM, video from Vista Grande Dr/Benttree Wy captured the subject walking WB on Vista Grande Dr then SB onto Cedar Point Wy. There were no other surveillance videos.
- 1/26/22 at 11:09:12, Marshall's phone showed the "In Call Service" application "ended". The phone backlight and other usage logs began logging data again, indicating Marshall was using the phone again. From 9:20 to 11:09, Marshall's phone showed limited activity compared with the rest of the day. This led us to believe Marshall was not actually using his phone and had left his phone at home.

(APD Special Operations Unit detectives walked from Trenton St to Marshall's house at around the same time of night. They walked it in 1-hour and 20-minutes.)

- 1/26/22 at 11:16:36 PM, Marshall sent Alexis an iMessage, "Did you make it home?" followed by an outgoing unanswered phone call to Alexis at 11:36:36 PM.

January 27, 2022

- 1/27/22 at around 8:15 AM – Rowena Gabe called Marshall Jones asking if she saw Alexis on January 26th. Marshall Jones says Alexis was at his house last night.
- 1/27/22 at around 8:22 AM – Rowena Gabe sent a text message to Marshall Jones asking what time she left his house. Marshall responded saying Alexis left around 9pm.
- 1/27/22 at around 1:09 PM, Oakley PD begins a missing persons investigation.
- 1/27/22 at around 4:15 PM, family located Alexis' Infinity on Trenton Ln. The doors were closed but unlocked. The keys were in the ignition, but the engine was off.
- 1/27/22 at around 4:25pm – Gwyn and Rowena, who were quarantined due to Covid decided to leave anyway to see her car. Gwyn told Marqus to open the trunk. Trunk was empty.
- 1/27/22 at around 5:07 PM, Oakley PD contacts Marshall, who admits Alexis was at his house last night and left around 9 PM, and may have been on her way to Alexis' friend's house, who lives near Trenton Ln. It was later learned this friend was out of town that night and Alexis would have known this.

January 28, 2022

- 1/28/22 at around 11:41 AM, Oakley PD detectives were canvassing Benttree Way when they happened to run into Marshall. Marshall gave conditional consent to search the residence (not allowing detectives to search the master bedroom and spare bedroom). Marshall gave consent to a forensic download of his cell phone. Marshall turned his phone over to detectives who went to OPD to extract the phone. Marshall left and likely

went back to work to retrieve his personal car. There was no probable cause that a crime occurred at this point in the investigation, therefore, investigators were unable to obtain a search warrant.

- 1/28/22 at around 1:21 PM, Marshall arrived at his mother's house. He backed his personal vehicle (**Leslie Clark's Ford Explorer**) into the driveway. He unloaded several large heavy garbage bags into the backyard or garage. The surveillance video was motion activated and recorded in 30-second clips so most of the actions are not caught on video.
- Marshall retrieved his phone from Oakley PD and returned to his mother's house. He and his mother left the house together and Marshall obtained a new phone and phone number from Metro PCS on 1/28/22 at 5:03 PM. (**Marshall loaded the garbage bags back to Leslie Clark's Ford Explorer while his mom, Alicia Coleman-Clark was hosting a karaoke party at her house**).
- 1/28/22 at around 6:41 PM, Marshall arrived at his sister's house in Vacaville, CA.
- 1/28/22 at around 7:11 PM, Marshall left his sister's house. Marshall had both his phones on him. One phone was powered off around 6:40 PM and the other powered off around 7:11 PM.
- 1/28/22 at around 8:52 PM, Marshall briefly turned one of his phones on in the area of Bradshaw Rd/Jackson Rd. Contra Costa County District Attorney's Investigators and Oakley PD detectives recovered video from a gas station at Bradshaw Rd/Jackson Rd that captured a vehicle similar to Marshall's traveling SB Bradshaw Rd and made a sudden, furtive lane change to the turn lane to turn EB Jackson Rd.
- Investigators who were later following the directions to Pioneer all missed the Watt Av exit (there were about 8 individual vehicles that all missed this exit) and ended up exiting Bradshaw Rd. We believe Marshall did the same thing and turned his phone on to orient himself.

January 29, 2022

- 1/29/22 at around 12:43 AM, Marshall turned his phone on and was in the area of SR-160/SR-12. He traveled to Antioch and arrived at his mother's house.
- 1/29/22 at around 1:00 AM, Marshall arrived at his mother's house.
- 1/29/22 at around 2:41 AM, Marshall arrived at his sister's house in Vacaville.

January 30, 2022

- 1/30/22, Marshall called in sick, leaving his boss a voicemail saying he had something to take care of.

January 31, 2022

- 1/31/22, Marshall's sister kicked him out of her home. He was seen on surveillance video carrying an extended firearm magazine and likely had a firearm on him while staying with his sister.
- 1/31/22, OPD and Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office located a cell phone screen that had been broken and separated from the device. The relevancy of this screen was not discovered until later, when Marshall's DNA was determined to be on the screen. Marshall' DNA was surreptitiously collected on 5/11/22.

February 1, 2022

- 2/1/22, Marshall stayed at his mother's house and was seen with a firearm.
- 2/1/22, OPD, APD, and CCCDA Investigators executed a search warrant at Marshall's home on Benttree. It was not immediately clear what investigators were searching for, but Luminol was used to search for the presence of blood. A small reaction occurred on the inside lid of the washer inside the house. A sample was collected and later found to have Alexis' DNA. Marshall's vehicle was seized and processed, and Alexis' DNA was located in the back of the vehicle, however, the source of the DNA could not be determined. The shower curtains in Marshall's bathroom were also missing.

February 2, 2022

- 2/2/22, Marshall flew from California to Washington and stayed with his father. He was seen on surveillance video at the airport and was not with anyone else.

February 3, 2022

- 2/3/22, APD and OPD executed a search warrant at Marshall's mother's house.

February 23, 2022

- 2/23/22, APD and OPD executed a search warrant at Marshall's sister's house in Vacaville. The directions to Pioneer were seized and investigators immediately drove to Pioneer to get a lay of the land. Multiple land, air, and water searches were conducted using K-9's, Contra Costa County Search and Rescue and Dive Teams, Amador County Search and Rescue and Dive Teams, CHP helicopter, FBI, and sonar specialists.

February 25, 2022

- 2/25/22, a volunteer with Klass Kids Foundation located Alexis' unique, hand drawn, cell phone case near Vista Grande Dr/Benttree Wy. Alexis' DNA was located on the case as well as Marshall's (Confirmed after 5/11).

April 1, 2022

- 4/1/22-4/5/22, OPD obtained a search warrant to drain an 8-million-gallon pond after finding suspicious anomalies during sonar searches and cadaver K-9 alerts on the lake. The operation was staffed and monitored around the clock, but nothing was located.

May 19, 2022

- 5/19/22. Alicia Coleman Clark was arrested and charged with Penal Code 32 (aiding & abetting) by OPD, but the DA declined to file charges. She was released.

June 1, 2022

- 6/1/22 at around 5:45 PM, Marshall Curtis Jones was killed after authorities said he lunged at officers with a knife
- 6/1/22 at around 10:00 PM – Oakley Chief Paul Beard along with Lieutenant Robert Roberts and Chief Inspector Arnold Threets arrived at Gabe's residence to inform them about what happened to Marshall Curtis Jones. Contra Costa County District Attorney Diana Becton was outside the apartment building waiting to be invited in.

June 2, 2022

- 6/2/22 at around 11:00 AM, Press conference at Oakley City Hall announcing the death of Marshall Curtis Jones.

This was not an all-inclusive list of our investigation and I have intentionally left out certain details.
