

# PETER CRISS' "GOOD LUCK" TOKEN

(Exactly like the one worn from 1974 to 1978)

A 2-inch diameter, aluminum, token like this one was worn, by Peter, first as an earring in 1974- then later, pinned to his stage attire, from 1975-1978. It can be seen in many studio session, as well as live, photos.

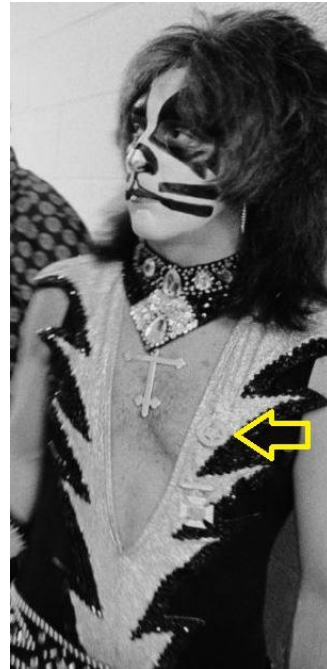
The text on the outer rim of the “Horseshoe/Good Luck” side of the token reads, "PETE AND LYDIA JULY 13 1966", and the story behind it, according to Lydia Criss, is that this specific date was the day (it was a Wednesday) that Peter & Lydia became each other's "steady" boyfriend and girlfriend. They were at the beach in Brooklyn, where there was a boardwalk arcade that had a machine which made these tokens. They cost \$.25 each, and Peter made two of them. One for Lydia, and one for him. After divorcing Lydia in 1979, Peter gave his token to long-time **KISS** collector Vinnie Gonzales- who, in turn, eventually sold it to the current owner. Today, its whereabouts is unknown.
