## INTRODUCTION





## Why Create This Documentary?


















The answer is *simple* - more people should know about Amy Zerner and Monte Farber. And this is one of the *greatest love stories* ever told.

One of the reasons this is true is because of Amy and Monte's pioneering success with their extensive line of over fifty best-selling illustrated books, book/oracle and Tarot card kits, board games, and even the first astrology themed cookbook. Their expertise in all metaphysical subjects - they call themselves "the multi-mediums" - not only popularized the topics to create today's broad market, but the letters they've received from several new stars in the M/B/S space proves that they helped create new authors inspired by their works and emboldened publishers to take a chance on these new people in the hope that they, too, would have numerous titles in print for one, two, even three plus decades like Amy and Monte, a track record that has never been equaled in what used to be called the New Age space back in 1988 when their first book was published. Publishing, however, is only one continent in The Enchanted World.

Do not expect weird, mystic music and smoky candles burning in the background. Instead, this is a grounded, participatory documentary demonstrating insight into Amy and Monte's daily lives, the constant feeding of new products and new ventures into The Enchanted World empire and into their memories (like New York in the 1960s, 1970s and 1980s), both via shared and via individual perspectives.

They are not perfect. They come from loving but complicated and heartbreaking backstories. While undeniably blessed with their gifts and with each other, their lives are not without struggle and lessons. Plus, they are so likeable and warm and approachable. And funny.



And yes, Amy is an artist. An insanely talented force of nature. Amy Zerner was the first artist to win a US National Endowment for the Arts Fellowship Award in the category of Painting for work that is all fabric, smashing once and for all the barrier between art and craft. There exists many compelling documentaries about female artists, and these usually center around the struggle for representation in a male-dominated industry and what it takes to be taken seriously. Ours is a refreshing look at the world of an established female artist, who works individually and with her husband (the yin to her yang), which combines spirituality, art, love, and slice-of-life anecdotes, which is very current and very "now". There is no antecedent to this type of story.

In fact, their beautiful and refreshing support for each other is clearly demonstrated when we learn that it was their idea to build on the success of Monte's first book/card set, KARMA CARDS to secure a deal for Amy's first masterpiece, the 78 3' x 2' tapestries she created for her classic ENCHANTED TAROT (a feat which took Amy two years to complete). This would begin the first of many collaborations where Monte would seamlessly illustrate with his words the art Amy creates which now accompanies their many published kits and works.

















We will see them at home in their natural element in Springs, East Hampton, New York, in the house that Amy has lived in since 1967. We will see them out and about in their surrounding community and famous idyllic beachfront locations.

We will be introduced to family, friends, colleagues, clients and interesting connections, both past and present, through an array of interviews, photos and quotes, which combine to add texture to the tapestry, which is the backdrop of their life.















We will see their creative process firsthand. How they collaborate, how they work independently – Monte with his writing projects, which now include collaborations with Hollywood studios for film and TV projects - and how Amy continues to create one-of-a-kind garments (sold exclusively at Bergdorf Goodman for the past 20 years!) bought by her elite list of clientele.

They continue to produce ideas for more books for major international publishers, which Amy will illustrate, creating magnificent collages in her unique NEA award-winning style which Monte seamlessly interprets, thereby "illustrating" her art with his words. They are a well-oiled machine, despite being in their 70s, and they show no signs of fatigue when a new bout of inspiration hits. I know, don't they look fantastic? Get their ASTROLOGY FOR WELLNESS book to adopt all their healthy lifestyle secrets!

The one question that has yet to be answered - when you have two accomplished subjects like Amy and Monte, who have done more in a handful of years than most do within a lifetime, and when creativity is breath and life, how do you know when you've created enough?





















His enjoyment of life was infectious.

I remember seeing Amy for the first time. She walked out onto the penthouse's rooftop patio with my then-girlfriend, who was as tired of me as I was of her. My eyes immediately went to Amy, the most beautiful woman that I had ever seen. I gave my then-girlfriend a perfunctory hello kiss and then walked transfixed past her to Amy and asked her if she wanted a joint. This was a fairly standard part of the late 1960s teenage courtship ritual, which I'd not outgrown.



When you love someone, you just enjoy watching them live, being themselves. We've felt that way about each other since 1975, being there for each other in every way we can to support whatever we each wanted to do, whether that was art and music for the first decade or when we added the writing, illustrating, and packaging of metaphysical teaching games and books and a couture fashion business to our creative mix.



The reason that we persevered and, in seven short months, decided to live together "for the summer" was that we each got a certain something out of being with each other that we knew we could not get from being with anyone else.

In 1979 Amy gave up. No, not on me, though no sane person would have blamed her if she had. She gave up using marijuana, which she had also been using daily, and cocaine, which she used in smaller doses than I had. I did not go along with her, or, to be more accurate, I did not grow along with her.

- Since 1988, Amy and Monte have created more than 50 books and oracle card decks (Illustrated by Amy Zerner and Written by Monte Farber), including several "evergreen" Mind/Body/Spirit classics that have been in print for decades such as *The Enchanted Tarot, Karma Cards*, and *The Psychic Circle*, two coloring books, and even the first astrology-themed cookbook
- All their works are published by some of the biggest publishers in the world with now over 3,000,000 copies of their work sold in 18 languages

- Fun Fact: Amy and Monte were the first to sell their tarot cards on HSN and QVC.
