Point Forward Sports Group Training Camp Process

A few things to note in addition to the process below:

- The kids should NOT be in the school outside of the gym. The Handicap Restrooms
 will be open in the gym for use and are the only facilities available during open gym
 hours (the school will be open to the Library patrons only). This limits interactions and
 ensures we know exactly what needs to be cleaned.
- Coaches are responsible for disinfecting all equipment and chairs, etc. (optional)
 the custodial staff will clean the RRs in the morning.
- Prior to participating, students must have the attached waiver signed by parent/guardian on file in the ADs office.
- Students are to enter one door leading to the gym to be screened there in the hallway.
 The questions/chart is attached. Any YES answer or Temperature of 100.3 or higher
 means the student must be sent home. The screening must take place before each
 session. The forms are to be turned in to the (office) for filing.

2022 Utqiagvik Camp Process:

The Covid-19 Waiver of Liability form must be filled out by all students before participating.

- All students will have temperatures checked and be screened prior to entering the gym. Appropriate records will be kept of all participants (see attached screening form). Any student found to be with symptoms or a temperature greater than 100.3 will not be permitted to participate. (ASAA Recommendation)
- The gym will be open on a schedule at the coaches and school district's discretion. In compliance with CDC protocols, the gym and equipment will be disinfected between uses.
- 3. Gym usage will only be open for current students and staff.
- 4. Locker rooms will remain locked and will not be available for use.
- 5. Social distance measures will be used for all fundamental and drill work. 7. If possible, when not exercising or competing, social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet should be maintained by students.
- 6. Water fountains will be off limits to all participants. Individual water bottles will be allowed for each participant. Sharing water bottles will not be permitted. 9. If Risk-Levels change in the community, open gym activities may be closed for use.
