Who are we?

Great Lakes Womens Shelter is a safe haven for women and children experiencing homelessness and/or domestic or family violence on Worimi land on the Mid North Coast of NSW.

Our specialised staff work alongside families empowering them to gain access to necessary services to support them to get back on their feet, such as legal, housing, financial, family support, counselling and identifying any other needs during their stay.

In our purpose designed new shelter, named Marrungbaa Garuwaga (*Worimi- meaning Good place by the sea*) GLWS provides supported accommodation for up to 10 families at any time, for up to 3 months

Thanks to the support of our local community and government grants, we have been blessed to build this state of the art shelter, to provide a dignified safe home for families, while they get back on their feet and back to living safe and fulfilled lives.

Our mission statement

We provide shelter and safety, while walking alongside resident families to empower them: to build dignity, self-esteem, practical life skills and the ability to move back into the community safely. We utilise crisis and early intervention programs to support vulnerable families in the community to forestall or reduce the effects of domestic and family abuse.

Through advocacy and support, we aim to educate our community to reduce the incidence and effects of domestic and family abuse and other causes of homelessness.

We cohesively work with other local support services to reach the best outcomes for all our residents and community clients.

Our vision:

To empower and educate our local community to reduce domestic and family violence and homelessness.

Our purpose:

To support vulnerable women and children at risk of domestic and family violence - and/or homelessness by providing safety, shelter, and support.

We aim to empower our clients with strength, dignity, and courage.

In January 2021, with the support of Women NSW (NSW Govt) we launched a pilot for a new Crisis Outreach (early intervention) program, to support women and children while they were waiting for a room in shelter. This program operated 3 days per week, and remained at capacity for the entire year. This program received 140 referrals in 2021, of those 140, 84 were domestic violence, the remaining had become homeless, mostly due to the Pandemic and the housing shortages that occurred as a result. We are still receiving multiple referrals every week, as the housing crisis is not decreasing, as a result we are aiming to run this program 5 days per week to meet the growing need.



SPONSOR THE SHELTER FOR 1 YEAR \$500,000 PER YEAR

Great Lakes Womens Shelter offers organisations, community groups, families and individuals the opportunity to sponsor the costs of engaging specialised staff, utilities, maintenance and day to day operational costs for 12 months.

\$500,000 will cover the operational wages and other staffing on-costs for up to 4 specialised case workers and managerial costs, as well as the running costs, utilities, transport for clients and other day to day costs.

By sponsoring our shelter, you are supporting our community and vulnerable residents, and personally committing to providing much needed support for women and children experiencing trauma.

The sponsorship funds that you provide for the year, directly support the specialised services provided by our staff to each resident woman and child in shelter.

SPONSOR A CASE WORKER FOR 1 YEAR \$50,000 PER YEAR

Great Lakes Womens Shelter offers organisations, community groups, families and individuals the opportunity to sponsor the costs of engaging a Shelter Case worker for 12 months. \$50,000 will cover the wages and other staffing on-costs, for a Permanent Part-time Caseworker for 21 hours per week, for a full year.

As a case worker sponsor, your name will be displayed on the wall of the staff room.

Tier 1 sponsors are invited to participate in shelter and local community events and other special days throughout the year.

By sponsoring a case worker , you are showing the community and our vulnerable residents that you are personally committed to providing support for women and children experiencing trauma. The sponsorship funds that you provide for the year, go directly to supporting the specialised services provided by our case workers to each resident woman and child in shelter.

SPONSOR A PROGRAM FOR 1 YEAR \$50,000 PER YEAR

Great Lakes Womens Shelter offers organisations, community groups, families and individuals the opportunity to sponsor the costs of providing a Crisis outreach program or a child support program for 12 months.

\$50,000 will cover the wages and other staffing on-costs, to run a specific program for a full year. As a Program sponsor, your name will be prominently displayed in either the Outreach room or the Children's Support room.

Tier 1 sponsors are invited to participate in shelter and local community events and other special days throughout the year.

By sponsoring a program, you are showing the community and our vulnerable residents that you are personally committed to providing support for women and children experiencing trauma. ADOPT A FAMILY BEDROOM \$10,000 PER YEAR

Great Lakes Womens Shelter offers organisations, community groups, families and individuals the opportunity to adopt a bedroom in our 10 Bedroom Shelter for women and children experiencing domestic and family violence and homelessness. Our bedrooms are home for an entire family during their shelter stay, and consist of a family bunk bed (as depicted above) and a wardrobe, tv and heating.

By sponsoring a room, you are showing the community and our vulnerable residents that you are personally committed to providing support for women and children experiencing trauma.

The sponsorship funds that you provide for the year, go directly to our crisis shelter and help to offset the cost of utilities, and specialised support services provided to our residents.

Tier 2 Sponsorship includes:

- Sponsor's name on room door- with the sponsor's name and whether or not the room is in honour or remembrance of someone
- During the holiday seasons, sponsors may be invited, but not required, to sponsor the family or an individual living in your room, to provide extra food, activities or excursion opportunities.

ADOPT A FAMILY PANTRY \$500 PER MONTH OR \$6000 PER YEAR

Why not "adopt a pantry" for a family for 1 month, 3 months, 6 months or 1 year? As an Adopt-a-Pantry supporter, you will be supporting the nutritional needs of women and children, to assist in their recovery from trauma.

Fresh fruit and vegetables are a human right and essential to our health and wellbeing.

Many of our families have not had access to good nutrition in the past, and have not learned how to prepare basic healthy meals.

The sponsorship funds that you provide for the year, go directly to purchasing fresh fruit, vegetables and meat for each family.

Tier 3 Sponsorship includes:

- Providing a family with healthy nutritious meals to support their journey back to being able to live a fulfilled and safe life
- During the holiday season, sponsors may be invited, but not required, to additionally sponsor the family by providing holiday season specific food, such as Easter Eggs, Mother's day or Xmas lunch or eating out opportunities, such as restaurant or café vouchers.
- Invitations to assist by providing recipes or food selections that may support the families' needs
- Invitations to Great Lakes Womens Shelter events throughout the year.
- Pantry sponsors have the opportunity to renew their annual sponsorship before the sponsorship offers are released to the community at the end of their term.

SPONSOR OUR SHELTER FOR A DAY \$1500 PER DAY

It costs approximately \$1500 per day to operate our shelter and provide support to up to 10 families.

Day-to-day operating costs cover everything from utilities, staffing costs, project management, toys and activities and so much more.

A day in shelter can be spent doing a wide variety of support services, activities, transport, crisis management, intervention, referrals, outreach support and more, in order to meet the needs of each woman and child in shelter.

The sponsorship funds that you provide will help us keep our doors open, and to provide much needed shelter and support services for up to 10 families at a time. All of our shelter families have experienced extreme traumas and experiences of either domestic and/or family violence and homelessness.

Tier 4 Sponsorship includes:

- Providing many families with shelter and support to aid in their trauma recovery, and empowering them to build their lives in safety and wellness.

Our Team

Our shelter is made up of an amazing team of specialist domestic violence and homelessness case workers and crisis outreach workers, children's case workers, a shelter manager and an operations manager.

We are governed by a Board of Management, made up of wonderful community members who dedicate their time and expertise to building and maintaining our community shelter.

We are part of a network of shelters under the umbrella of Women's Community Shelters. There are now 10 WCS shelters NSW wide with more planned, to meet the need for crisis accommodation in communities across the state.


