Great Lakes Womens Shelter is a nurturing, healing home environment, which provides safety, support and time to recover after trauma.

Our wheelchair accessible, 10 bedroom shelter is open in Forster.

Each woman has her own room to share with her children, with shared living, dining and bathrooms.

Giving back to your community

Great Lakes Womens Shelter is partly funded by the NSW Department of Communities and Justice (through Womens Community Shelters) philanthropic contributions and by donations from local businesses and community members.

Since 2016 when we opened our doors, the NSW Government have provided approximately 40% of our day-to-day operational funding.

GLWS has a fundraising goal of approx \$400,000 per year, to not only keep the doors of the shelter open but to tackle Domestic and Family Violence in our community through outreach support, children's case management, prevention programs and community education (across the life span).
