DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Into the Woods is a rich musical that explores the themes of desire, consequence, and redemption. As the characters navigate unexpected hardships, the story reveals the cost of sin and the need for repentance, echoing Biblical truths from Proverbs 16 and other scriptures. The woods come to symbolize the trials of life—where faith is tested (James 1:1–27), choices carry lasting effects (Exodus 34:7), and growth often comes through suffering. The musical emphasizes the problem of pride, the power of words and actions, and the importance of family and community. One of the most profound messages is that no one is truly alone. In a broken world, we are called to bear one another's burdens (Galatians 6:2) and trust in God's greater plan, even in uncertainty. Ultimately, *Into the Woods* reminds us that worldly desires are fleeting, but lasting hope and restoration are found in seeking God and embracing His forgiveness, wisdom, and enduring love.
