Momence, Illinois Est. 1889 - Re-Est. 2024

121 East Washington Street was built as part of a four unit building in 1889 by Lester Calkins and features Mesker Bros. Cornice and Window Caps which are still intact today.

The original owner of this new building was William Spry who ran the "Four Spry Tavern" from December 1889 to August 1905. Fred Ceelen continued to run a tavern until 1907 when Momence Township went "dry" forcing Fred to move his tavern to Ganeer Township. In 2010 the building was sold to Tony and Debbie Lampley. Tony and Debbie took the restoration of this building to a whole new level. They also added a beautiful staircase to the lower level that was turned into a beautiful and usable space for their Illinois Wine Store "Off The Vine."
