FAIRVIEW CEMETERY GUIDELINES

Madison Village

According to Madison Village Ordinances and Administrative Policies, the following guidelines shall be kept in regard to Fairview Cemetery within Madison Village:

- There shall be no full grave plantings. Flowers to be cared for by the family may be planted on graves within twelve inches (12") of the marker. No trees or shrubs are to be planted without the consent of the Sexton.
- Fences, hedges, curbing, and enclosures of any kind around lots or graves are forbidden without the approval of the Sexton.
- The Village of Madison shall not be liable in case of loss due to accident or vandalism to graves, headstones, or flowers.
- Ornamentation shall not exceed 24" in height.
- Individual taste in ornamentation and improvement of lots will be respected; however, the Cemetery Sexton reserves the right to prohibit, remove or modify any structure, improvement or object on any lot which it may consider injurious to the general good appearance of the grounds, and particularly to adjacent lots, before, as well as after, the internments are made.
- Any ornamentation that does not meet Village guidelines or were not approved by Sexton will be removed and placed near the workshop garage for 14 days for pick up. Items not picked up are subject to disposal.
- The Madison Village reserves the right to promulgate and enforce other rules and regulations as are deemed to be required.
- The Cemetery shall be open to all visitors from sunrise to sunset.
- Artificial flowers may be placed on lots seasonally from November 1st until April 1st. Any plastic flowers left after April 1st will be removed by the Madison Village staff and disposed of properly.
