

**RESOLUTION NO. 11 - 2024**

**A RESOLUTION FORMERLY NAMING THE  
"MADISON VILLAGE ARCOLA CREEK WETLANDS PARK"**

WHEREAS, on the west side of Hubbard Road to the south of the Madison Senior Center, the Village owns approximately 19 acres of former nursery lands; and

WHEREAS, the Village, in partnership with the Lake County Soil & Water Conservation District, and with grant funding through the H2Ohio program administered by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources as well as other public funding, has completed restoration of historic wetlands, inclusive of relocation and restoration of 1,300 linear feet of stream which now meanders through the restored wetlands; and

WHEREAS, as noted by the Lake County Soil & Water Conservation District, vernal pools, widespread seeding of native wetland plants, and the reestablishment of natural hydrology have turned this area into a thriving ecosystem; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the foregoing, the Council desires to give the property a formal name recognizing its unique nature and dedication to future generations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Village's property aforesaid is and shall henceforth be known as the "Madison Village Arcola Creek Wetlands Park."

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest time provided by Ohio law.
