RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 2022

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2022 LAKE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, natural, technological and human-caused hazards can adversely impact the Village of Madison and its residents; and

WHEREAS, significant structural, historical and economic losses could result from an occurrence of a natural, technological, or human-caused hazard event; and

WHEREAS, undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses Madison incurs as a result of said hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the Madison Village Council has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the hazard mitigation plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding, and, by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five years; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative, joint effort is a proven, efficient way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Lake County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Madison has partnered with Lake County to update the existing Lake County Hazard Mitigation Plan in an effort to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the Village, as well as to continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to adopt the 2022 Lake County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the 2022 Lake County Hazard Mitigation Plan, the public summary of which is on file for inspection at the office of the Clerk of Council, is hereby adopted by the Village of Madison.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that, except as otherwise provided by § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the protection and preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Madison and for the further reasons that immediate adoption of the 2022 Lake County Hazard Mitigation Plan is necessary to maintain hazard mitigation funding as well as to be prepared in the utmost for future hazards affecting the life and safety of its citizens, WHEREFORE; this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon its passage.
