

ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF COLE BURTON CONTRACTORS, LLC FOR PAVEMENT REPAIRS TO HYDER AND KIM DRIVES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SAME; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, advertisement for bids for the Hyder and Kim Drives pavement repairs project occurred pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, said bids were publicly opened and read on September 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid was received from Cole Burton Contractors, LLC (Ohio entity no. 4828607) in the amount of Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Zero Cents (\$218,314.00), which bid was less than the Village Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost, that estimate being Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$220,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer, who opines that the company is a responsible bidder capable and qualified to perform the work, and, that its bid was in compliance with all bid, contract, and legal requirements, recommends the contract be awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Cole Burton Contractors, LLC in the amount of Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Zero Cents (\$218,314.00) for the Hyder and Kim Drives pavement repairs project is hereby accepted and the contract awarded.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to forthwith enter into a contract with Cole Burton Contractors, LLC in accordance with the specifications of the Village Engineer, the bid, and the contract documents.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Madison because timely award and start of the project is needed to meet seasonal construction deadlines; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon passage.


