ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 14-2006, AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH COLUMBARIUM FEES FOR FAIRVIEW CEMETERY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns and operates Fairview Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the fees for the Cemetery's new columbarium(s), which the Administration has recommended be, per niche, the following: \$1,000.00 for Village residents and \$1,200.00 for non-residents; and

WHEREAS, the Council accepts the recommendation of the Village Adminstration and now desires to amend Ordinance No. 14-2006, as amended, Section 1, to establish columbarium fees for Fairview Cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 14-2006, as amended, is and shall hereby be amended by adding the following line item and pricing to the Fee Schedule, to wit:

Description	Resident of Madison	Non-Resident of Madison

Columbarium niche (including engraving)	\$1,000.00	\$1,200.00

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That except as explicitly modified and amended herein, Ordinance No. 14-2006, as amended, is and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Madison and further to immediately address costs related to internment of remains, as detailed in the preamble to this Ordinance; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon passage.
