ORDINANCE NO. 4-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 3-2022, TO AMEND PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, STATE OF OHIO, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2022 TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2022 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

<u>Section 1</u>. BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Madison, State of Ohio, that Ordinance 3-2022, Permanent Annual Appropriation Ordinance for 2022, be amended to reduce appropriations in the Coronavirus Relief Fund (2151) as follows:

<u>Section 2</u>. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore; approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditures.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village, and so is to provide sufficient funds for the operation of the Village; and, THEREFORE, this ordinance shall take effect as an emergency ordinance in accordance with the provision of Article V, Section 5.2 of the Madison Village Charter.
