RESOLUTION NO. 16-2024

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF KEEGAN VAUGHT TO THE POSITION OF PART TIME PATROL OFFICER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Officer Keegan Vaught has informed the Village that he will be resigning from his current position as full-time patrol officer effective at the conclusion of his shift on December 30, 2024, but that he desires and has sought re-appointment as a part-time patrol officer; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has informed the Council that he desires upon the effective date of Officer Vaught's resignation as a full-time patrol officer to reappoint him to the position of part-time patrol officer; and

WHEREAS, confirmation of said re-appointment is now sought pursuant to § 9.2 of the Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That subject to the formal resignation of Officer Keegan Vaught as a full-time patrol officer effective as of the conclusion of his shift on December 30, 2024, the Council does hereby confirm the immediate reappointment of Keegan Vaught to the position of part time patrol officer with the Village Police Department.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Madison, and, for the further reason that immediate passage is necessary to provide personnel for the good and orderly operation of the Police Department it shall, therefore, take effect and

be in full force from and upon its adoption if adopted by the affirmative vote of at least four members of Council and otherwise at the earliest time provided by Ohio law.
